

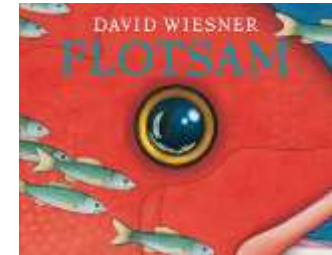


OPEN AFTERNOON

Year 3 will be sharing their Flotsam Art Projects and writing, as well as their current writing about the poem: The Spider and the Fly. They will also be showing you some maths games that can be played at home: TT Rockstars and Hit the Button on iPad for parents to play with their children.



Year 4 are planning an 'Africa is not a Country' afternoon. Activities include: deciphering hieroglyphics, reviewing the mummification process, researching Africa, atlas work and African art.

Year 5 will be combining History and Art by designing and sketching Anglo Saxon brooches. We will be using our primary source investigation skills to find out what patterns and materials were used and then our sketching skills to make our designs look 3D, we would really love for parents to join us, get involved and have a go!



Year 6 will be inviting parents to join in some art. Our current unit of work is painting with watercolours.
