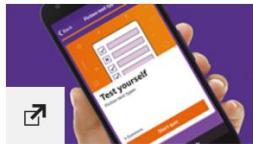

If you're an Android user, you can download it from the Google Play Store.

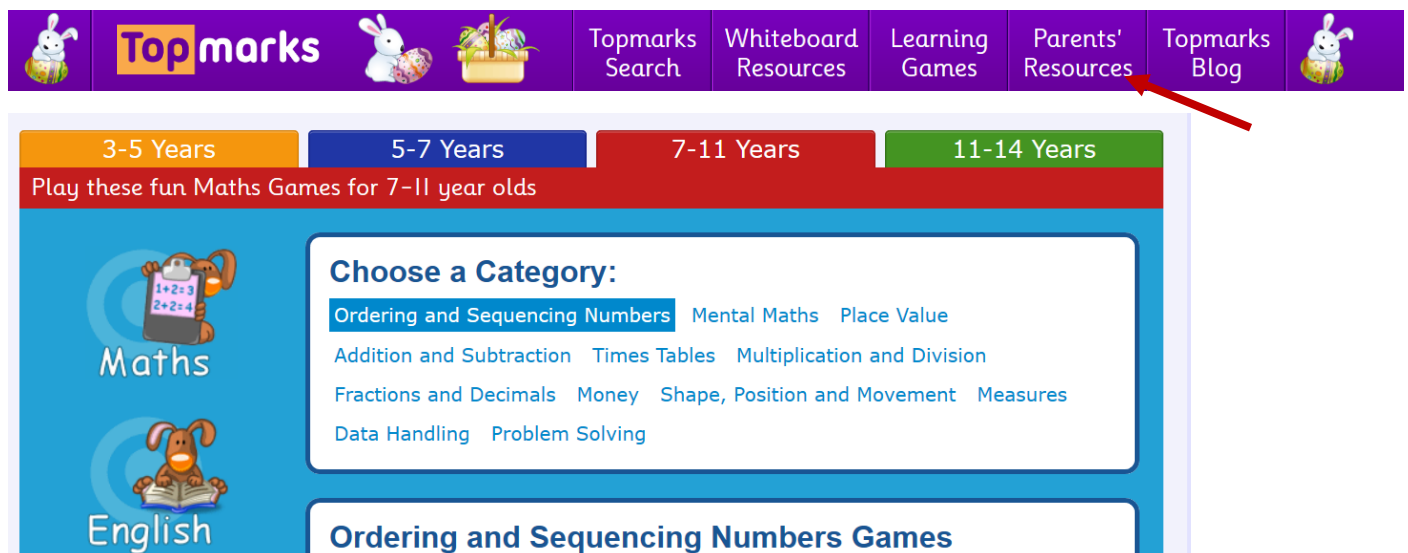
