$$9 + 9 = 18$$

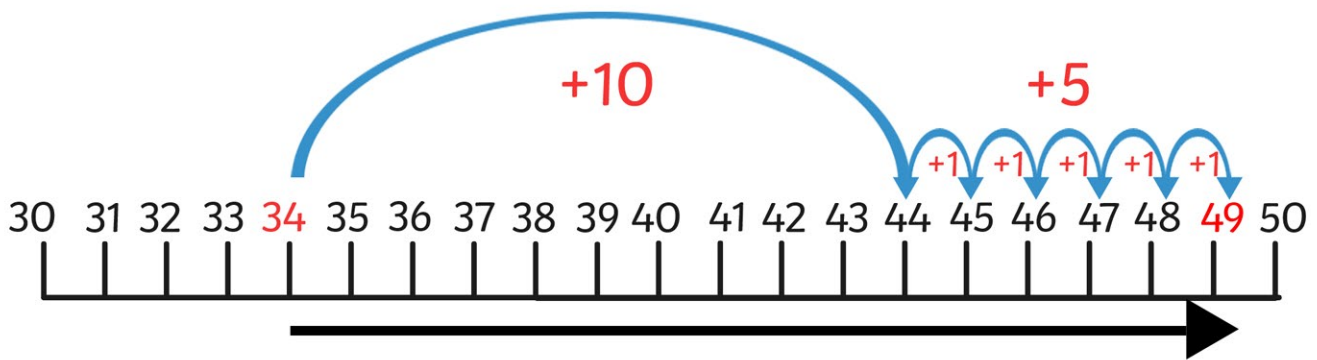
$$10 + 10 = 20$$

Mental Maths Strategies

Counting On

For adding and subtracting numbers close to each other.
This strategy works well with a number line or square.
You can even do it mentally!

$$34 + 15 =$$

Near Doubles

For adding similar numbers.

Double one of the numbers and adjust by adding or subtracting the difference.

$$26 + 25 =$$

I know double 25 is 50.

$$26 + 25 =$$

1 more than double 25 = 51
