Breakfast brain power

We believe that it is important that children start the day with a good breakfast. Each day children will be served foods that are rich in grains, fibre and protein and low in added sugar to help boost attention span, concentration and memory.

Children will enjoy sitting down with their friends to refuel with toast, cereals, juice and water.

Staff are seated with the children during meal times to encourage a "family" type atmosphere. At least one member of staff holds a current Basic Food Hygiene certificate and all food and drink complies with dietary and religious requirements.

Evidence shows that introducing elements of physical activity and play to children before school starts can engage their minds and prepare them for the day ahead. The morning sessions aim to stimulate the learning experiences of your child.

Children who attend will enter school alert and ready for the day, having engaged their minds and body whilst learning a host of valuable skills including:

- Being more alert for a day of learning within the school
- Understanding the importance of a healthy lifestyle
- Improved coordination, balance, agility and flexibility
- Appropriate and effective communication with others

- Using tactics and strategies to increase chances of success



After school club

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Activities

There will be a range of indoor and outdoor activities daily as well as a quiet area where children can relax and do some homework or reading if they wish. Children will be encouraged to take part in physical activity each day to help them stay fit, but also have some quieter activities with friends to recharge their batteries.

The fun, physical activities are designed to appeal to every child. Our wraparound care sessions encourage fun-based physical activities, rather than traditional sports. The aim is to encourage children to get physically active through play, placing emphasis on inclusion rather than specific sports skills and techniques. This, in turn, improves social skills, self-esteem, balance, coordination and physical wellbeing.

The after school club reflects how important the school considers a healthy lifestyle to be, and therefore the activities are set up to engage the children's mind, body and soul.

The club will provide a relaxed environment to support children's learning and individual interests. Activities will be designed to be engaging and challenging for the ages and abilities of each child.

Food and drink

Children will be provided with food and drink daily. Healthy snacks will be provided, as well as fresh fruit and water.

If your child has any allergies or dietary requirements please ensure that these are added on to the booking form online. Please feel free to discuss any special food requirements your child may have with the after school club manager.

Staff are seated with the children during meal times and encourage a “family” type atmosphere. At least one member of staff holds a current Basic Food Hygiene certificate and all food and drink complies with dietary and religious requirements. Fresh fruit and drinking water is available to children at all times.

Signing in and out...

- Children must be signed in by a member of Premier Education staff upon arrival to any activity or provision.
- A parent/guardian who made the booking must collect the child unless prior written consent is given for someone else to collect them.
- Premier Education implements a ‘Password collection’ system at every setting. Therefore, where another adult is collecting the child, they must know the collection password for us to release the child and sign over the duty of care.
- Parents/guardians or another adult (where permitted) must physically sign out each child upon collection.



Missing or unallocated children

In the unlikely event that a child goes missing, the following procedure will be undertaken:

- School staff will be informed of the missing child.
- Wraparound Care supervisors will search the inside of the building and delegate an outside search of the building to another member of staff.
- If the child remains missing, the emergency services and parents/guardians will be contacted.





Behaviour

Whilst attending wraparound care, children are expected to:

- Follow the school values.
- Use socially acceptable behaviour.
- Respect one another, accepting differences of race, gender, ability, age and religion.
- Choose and participate in a variety of activities.
- Ask for help if needed.
- Enjoy their time at the club.

Positive behaviour is encouraged by:

- Staff acting as positive role models.
- Praising appropriate behaviour.
- Informing parents about individual achievements.

Dealing with inappropriate behaviour:

Challenging behaviour will be addressed in a calm, firm and positive manner. In the first instance, the child will be given the opportunity to reflect on their behaviour and make the correct decision on how to behave moving forward. If a child doesn't choose to improve their behaviour it may be necessary for a child to be temporarily removed from the activity. Staff will explain why the behaviour displayed is deemed inappropriate. Staff will encourage and facilitate mediation between children to try to resolve conflicts through discussion and negotiation. Staff will consult with parents to formulate clear strategies for dealing with persistent inappropriate behaviour.

If, after consultation with parents and the implementation of behaviour management strategies, a child continues to display inappropriate behaviour, the club may decide to exclude the child. The reasons and processes involved will be clearly explained to the child and their parent/carer. All behaviour issues will be recorded.

First aid

All incidents are dealt with by a qualified first aider and will be recorded in the wraparound care accident book.

Incidents will be accurately reported to the parents/carer upon collection and signed by a member of the after school club staff.

Accident records will give details of time, date and nature of the accident, details of the child involved, type and location of the injury, action taken, and by whom.

Parents of any child who becomes unwell during wraparound care will be contacted immediately. If a child is sent home during school hours, the after school club will be informed of their absence by a member of the school admin/office staff.





Booking with a credit card

You must have pre-booked your child into the session online. Any child not pre-booked is not covered by our insurance and will not be allowed into the session. There are a limited number of spaces available for each session and these are allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Booking online

1. The simplest way to book your child is to visit; www.premier-education.com
2. Click on 'Book a course'.
3. In the 'Location' box type in your school's postcode and click "search".
4. Select your venue and click the Wraparound Care option.
5. Select the session and day you would like to book.
6. Register your details or log in if you are a returning customer.
7. Follow booking process and select 'card' in Payment Method section to complete your booking
8. Once you've completed your booking you will receive email confirmation.



Last minute bookings:

We understand that plans change, often at short notice, and we will try to be flexible to accommodate most situations.

Bookings for all Premier Education services must be made in advance of the session.

A session cannot be added online less than two hours before the session starts.

Late fees...

Premier Education understand that, at times, parents/guardians may be delayed in collecting their child, and we will always ensure that we do our utmost to support our families where possible.

When a child is collected late, it has a subsequent impact on our staff members and quite often the setting where our provision takes place (e.g. a school). Therefore, Premier Education reserves the right to charge a 'Late collection fee'.

If you are running behind schedule and your child will be collected late, please make our head office aware so our team at the site can be notified in advance.

In the event of a child not being collected on time, we will attempt to call the parents/guardians and an emergency contact at least three times. If we are still unable to make contact, we will follow our Safeguarding policy and uncollected child procedure.

We always strive to offer parents/guardians the support needed; however, if late collections become a recurring event, we reserve the right to fully withdraw our service.

Booking services fee...
