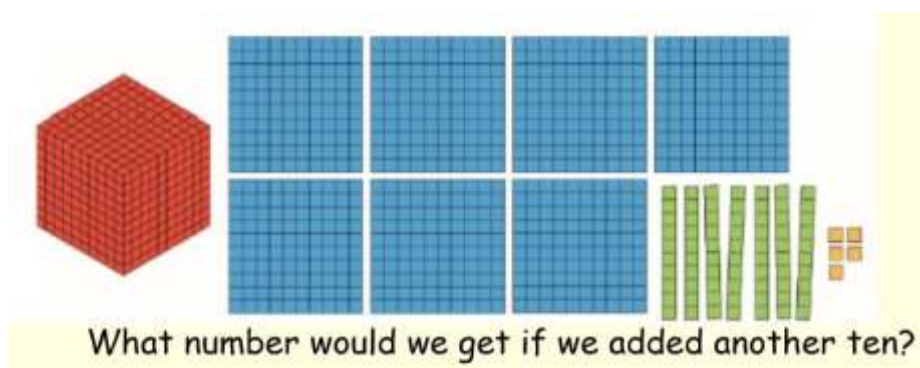
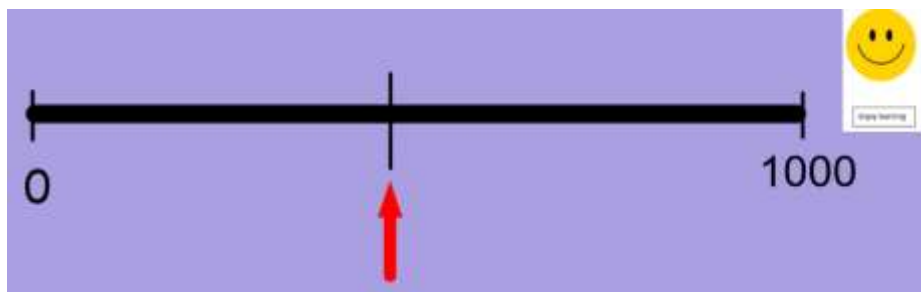


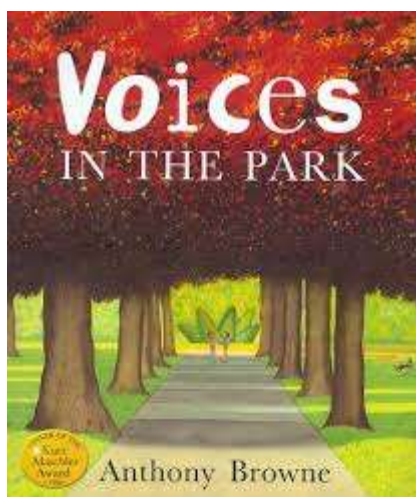
## September 2020

It has been a great start to the year for Year 4.

In maths, we have reactivated some of our learning from Year 3 so that we have all the understanding we need for our Year 4 learning – this has included playing lots of games! We have begun to explore numbers beyond 1000: comparing, ordering and using our estimating skills to benchmark numbers and round them to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.



In English, we have been reading the story 'Voices in the Park' by Anthony Browne. We have been introduced to fronted adverbials as well as producing Cinquain poems about the lively 'Smudge'. Our final outcome is writing our own story which includes the voice of three different characters.
