


September 2020

In Maths we have been thinking back to our year 2 learning, giving extra focus to place value. We have been making 3 digit number with different maths manipulatives and learning how to partition a number in different ways.

Let's partition this hundreds number:




What is the hundreds value?


What is the tens value?

What is the ones value?

How can we regroup 326?

3 hundreds, 2 tens, 6 ones. 

Or, 2 hundreds, ? tens, 6 ones



In English we have been working from a 'whole school' text – Voices in the Park by Anthony Browne. We have been working on our writing skills including building sentences, good use of adjectives and using conjunctions to create sentences with more information. We have produced several outcomes including colour poems, where we thought about how colour can represent emotions. The highlight of our learning for September was when we received a letter from Anthony Brown asking our Year 3 children to write the next part of the story, Voice 5!



In other areas of the curriculum we have been learning how to use sketch lines in art, how to use an atlas in geography and how to develop good learning behaviours in PSHE. We have also been speaking and listening in French! We can now say hello, ask how you are and respond when you ask how we are!
