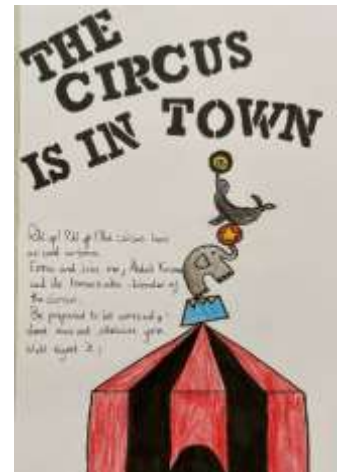
English
