



## FOAH meeting 13<sup>th</sup> April 4.00 -5.00 pm

Easter Jars – how much was made? **£158 Matched funding - £2500 raised last term**  
Interactive whiteboards - *fitted over Easter. Computing room board funded by FOAH.*

### Summer term events

- Summer 1 agreed Movie nights within bubbles are likely to be an event that won't need cancelling. HT agreed to support these and we thought might be more successful in smaller groups as behaviour and attention has been a problem in the past.

### May

1. Movie Nights – £5 per child – includes popcorn, drink and sweets. More details TBC nearer the time but they will be held in year bubble groups in the hall.  
*What films? Can Netflix/Disney+ be used? Different films for different year groups. FOAH to devise a list of them to be shared with children and they can then vote for what they would like. Flyers to be made. Can we buy a popcorn machine with FOAH money – EF agrees.*
2. Food allergies
3. Licence to show films – *DC says we have this for rest of year*
4. Safeguarding – register taken by staff and SLT member to supervise collection of children with a one way system for leaving through the hall – *Risk assessment will be needed. EF will be there on each night. 2 parent helpers and at least 1 member of staff + EF.*

*will review nearer the time regarding covid restrictions.*

- Ice-cream parlours could be held outside if necessary

**June / July** Ice-cream Fridays – if the weather is nice, ice-creams to be on sale at the end of the school day on June 18<sup>th</sup>, July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> *will review nearer the time regarding covid restrictions.*

- FOAH suggested family events. HT stressed that this could only be facilitated if restrictions lifted and that staff may not be able to attend. Wiser to have one event on a Friday evening and another on a Saturday sine staff might have own family commitments which would stop them from attending.

**July** Family Walk Event – likely to be on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> July and details TBC nearer the time.

**July** Summer Fair – Date TBC but likely to be Friday 16<sup>th</sup> or Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> July.  
*LINS unlikely to be doing a Summer Fair due to covid. May be too difficult if restrictions of numbers are still in place.*

### Other:

- Discussed sports day refreshments and since have thought Year 6 Parent events with refreshments would be good – to come back to at next meeting *may not be an event that parents can come to but if they are able to it would be ideal to have refreshments. Date will be announced to parents soon.*

- Discussed other events in the future such as quizzes and murder mystery events
- Year 7 reunion considered for those children who left last year – *don't think this is viable at the moment*
- Considered asking well-being committee if FOAH could fund something for children's well-being – Miss Coulter was asked to do this. *When I did pupil view children did speak about outdoor games so this would definitely be appreciated. A change of ball in upper school (currently sponge)*
- AP will transfer cost of board May – *EF to find out amount -£3000*
- Bank signatories need changing - *Bank mandate – returned to back and not rejected.*  
*No current volunteers for treasurer.*
- Leavers' books cost? £ 580 – Hoodies pay for themselves – *last year leavers books and hoodies were given to year 6. Would like to ask FOAH to pay for leavers books and then potentially ask parents to pay for hoodies if they want them. If we could have an event to raise money for both, that would be the best solution. Or could we ask for a voluntary contribution -come back to this at next meeting.*

*We could have a year 6 disco this year as they are in a year group bubble – FOAH usually pay for this. We could have a silent disco – saves money on a DJ and could be done outside.*

- Safeguarding – request for financial support with all day visit – all year groups, staff and parents workshops £820 total cost (*FOAH paid for it last year*) *FOAH agree to pay for this year.*

*EF will check how much money is in the bank. With hoodies, leavers books, Freedom from Abuse workshop and smart board money will be limited for September where fundraising events are so limited. Can we ask other parents if they are able to do 'match funding'.*

*Summer car wash?*

*Each year group to come up with a fundraising event?*

*Sponsorships from local businesses? Co-op/Tesco (remind parents about Amazon Smile)*

*School lottery – one question survey*

*Have we ever asked for direct donations – add to FOAH newsletter.*
