We have performed role-plays where we took turns interviewing Petit or acting in the role of Petit, and we have written our own memoirs as Petit as he attempted his walk across the towers.

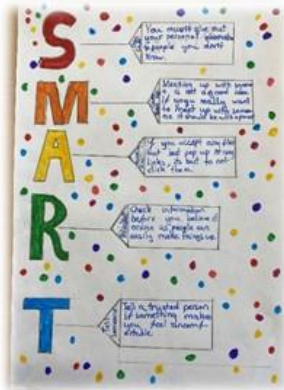




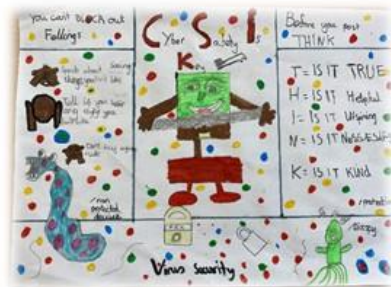
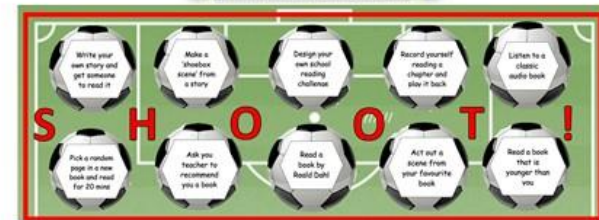
