TOPIC TITLE/SUBJECT: PSHE Learning Behaviours/Rules and Safety/Friendships and Bullying/PANTS

Skills

What we already know

-Learning behaviours, aim high, be curious, enjoy learning, have a go, ready to learn, work together, rules, class charter, PANTS, respect, clean, hygienic, safety, health, worry, friendship, trust, happiness, bullying, anti-bullying, special, unique, male, female, private parts, penis, testicles, vulva, vagina, uterus, consent.

Vocabulary

- Begin to display the desired learning behaviours
- show independence in learning, work with others, aim high in learning, manage distractions
- Show an ability to keep themselves clean (proper hand washing etc.)
- Display skills needed to make and sustain friendships as well as features of good and bad friendships
- Understand why we should ask for help and where to get help in different situations
- Understand what appropriate touch is
- To explore the differences between male and female bodies
- To consider appropriate and inappropriate physical contact and consent

Children will have learnt school and class rules in KS1

TERM: Autumn

- Children will already have an awareness of what bullying is
- Children should have an awareness of how to keep clean from KS1 and home
- Some children will already display the desired learning behaviours (for example being able to work well with others)
- Children should know the main body parts and the PANTS rule
