Differentiated challenges for warmups (using Charanga)

Perform:

- Sustain a rhythmic part on an instrument (ostinato, drone, etc) to accompany singing
- Perform, paying attention to song structure
- Perform with control and awareness of what others are singing/playing.
- Perform a song in 4 groups, adding and removing layers to change the dynamics
- Rehearsing and performing with percussion and voices to an audience
- Compose:
- Understand processes of composition and minimalism
- Create (dotted) rhythmic patterns with awareness of timbre and duration.
- Appraise:
- Identify a song's structure and layers of music
- Explore the phrasing of a song's melody
- Describe different purposes of music in history/other cultures.
- Evaluate performances
- Using Symbols and notation
- Follow a score showing the structure of a piece of music and notation

Skills

What we already know How to compose and perform melodies using 2 or 3 notes.

Some awareness of notes and their names on a musical stave

Sing songs from memory, using accurate pitch and tune.
Singing in parts (assemblies) and listening to/singing music from a variety of cultures

Glockenspiel 1 (yr3) - Revise, play and read the notes C, D, E, F + G.


Listening Centre Activity to be done at midpoint of this unit: Listen to /appraise Fur Elise and Symphony No 5

Application/ Outcomes

Part 1

- Revise, play and read the notes C, D, E, F + G.
- Learn to sing the chorus of a song.
- Learn a glockenspiel accompaniment for a song using notes F & G
- Perform a song in four groups, adding and removing layers to change the dynamics

Part 2

- Rearrange the structure of a song experimenting with notes C, D, E, F + G
- Perform a song in two groups in a new structure
- Record and evaluate a song performance, then make improvements
