TOPIC TITLE/SUBJECT: English -Atlas of Adventures

What we already know

Vocabulary

Grammar:

Capital letter, full stop, comma, noun phrase, preposition, adjective, synonym, thesaurus, verb, adverbs, proper noun, past tense, first person, coordinating conjunction, paragraph

Subject Vocabulary: map, continents, atlas, radio, broadcast

Speaking/Listening:

Oral Rehearsal/Presenting: performs stories and poems, identifying appropriate expression, tone, volume and use of voices. Participates, speaking audibly in a range of situations e.g. drama, formal presentations and debates

Questioning: poses and answers questions that will help make sense of a problem

Talking with others: works in groups with minimum supervision

- Use conjunctions for cohesion and to add detail
- Use past and present tense mostly correctly
- Use prepositions for cohesion and to add detail
- Use paragraphs
- Use the range of punctuation taught up to and including Y3 mostly correctly (e.g., apostrophes for possession, commas in lists)

Word: Use of the suffixes -er, -est in adjectives

TERM: Summer

Sentence: Subordination (using when, if, that, because) and co-ordination (using or, and, but). Expanded noun phrases for description and specification [for example, the blue butterfly, plain flour, the man in the moon]

Text: Correct choice and consistent use of present tense and past tense throughout writing

Punctuation: Use of capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks to demarcate sentences

Application/ Outcomes

Joining independent clauses, using co-ordinating conjunctions.

Post card written in the past tense, first person. Factual setting description using prepositions and persuasive vocabulary.

Summary and selection of information from a range. Performance – radio broadcast of a setting description. Hot seating - interview

Factual description, using expanded noun phrases and precise vocabulary.

Diary entry to include facts and event recount.
