- To recognise when they need help and develop the skills to ask for this

What we already know

Year 3 – Keeping Myself Safe

- That each person's body belongs to them the difference between appropriate/inappropriate/safe/unsafe physical contact
- The importance of asking permission
- Where to get help and advice (family, school and other)
- How to recognise and report feelings of being unsafe or feeling bad about any adult
- How to report concerns or abuse and the vocabulary to do so
