Discussion: links between money and happiness. Can money affect your wellbeing and health?

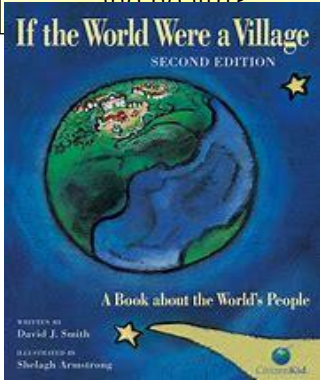


Visit from 'Citizens Advice Bureau' - managing finances and budgeting every day. Group work based on prioritising debt.
