TOPIC TITLE: Art – Mixed media.

<p>Vocabulary</p> <p>hue value intensity primary colours monochromic warm/cool</p> <p>mixed media mediums colour shading multi media expression/emotion analogous colours (three colours next to each other on a colour wheel) balance rhythm printmaking linocut</p>	<p>Skills: drawing, printmaking, painting and colour</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use line drawing over a photograph to express a mood. • 3D mixed media • Sketching and shading skills to make an image look 3D in a range of mediums (pencil, coloured pencils and pastels) • Using watercolours to shade between three analogous colours. • Layering watercolour over crayon. • Creating a simple block print repeating pattern and adding this over mixed media portrait. • Continuous critique of the work of artists, their own and that of their peers. 	<p>What we already know</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pencil skills (smooth shading) • Collage skills • Applying colour with coloured pencils and pastels. • How colours are displayed on a colour wheel. • Ability to identify that art takes different forms. • Can look and talk about the work of artists. • Can form opinions of the work of other artists.
<p>Application/ Outcomes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use different shading techniques for different purposes within own work. Apply to pieces to create mood and depth. • Explore colour theory linked to emotional reactions. • Use a picture of themselves and add pencil line drawing over it to express a mood. Class art gallery for other children to see if they know the feelings the artist was trying to convey. • Use a range of materials and mediums to create a 3D mixed media portrait. Reflect and review on 3D piece • Develop a key element of their work: line, tone, pattern, texture that defines their work as theirs. Create a block print from this. • Use printmaking to layer over other media. • Create final piece with refined techniques improved on reflection. 	<p>Concepts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using two or more mediums on one piece of artwork is considered mixed media. • To know that multi-media is when an artist has used technology to alter their work. • To use multiple mediums on one piece to convey a mood or emotion. • To recreate the same image in multiple mediums in one piece. • Shading and colour fading. • Taking inspiration from key artists. 	<p>Referenced artists/architects</p> <p>Picasso Eileen Agar</p>
