Vocabulary

Independence, responsibility, peer pressure, transition, change, emotions, puberty, friendship, CONSEQUENCES, choices, divorce, bereavement, separation, wellbeing, health, maturity.

Skills

- To understand that increasing independence brings increased responsibility
- To take responsibility for my own safety
- To Identify and manage pressure to get involved in risky situations
- Recognise when we need help and develop the skills to ask for help, resisting peer pressure
- To learn about changes including bereavement, separation and divorce
- To prepare for changes (including emotional) through creating a checklist in preparation for secondary school

Role on the wall posters to show understanding of different types of responses to peer pressure: Passive, aggressive and assertive – what are the differences?
