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<b>Other/Cross Curricular Links with English/Maths/Adaptation for SEND</b> MATHS- symmetry, accurate measuring for tile template GEOGRPAHY- Barcelona-Gaudi work SEN- simplify Morris designs for drawing activity, vocabulary word mat, picture resource cards of artists/architects, adult support					<b>Application/ Outcomes</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Research the work of architect William Morris and Antonio Gaudi also tessellation work of Escher</li> <li>Home learning- Gaudi inspired mosaic project</li> <li>Recreate a William Morris nature-based pattern (continue outwards from a piece of W.M design or recreate the other half of a symmetrical design)</li> <li>Look at links with Islamic art</li> <li>Observe a range of naturally occurring patterns Eg fruit cross section, leaves. Children make close observational sketches in sketchbooks</li> <li>Select part of a drawing made to make a relief template for printing a tile (using foam sheet)</li> <li>Use block printing ink to create a repeating print design from tile template</li> <li>Print onto material as well as paper.
