# BEING SAFE AT SCHOOL

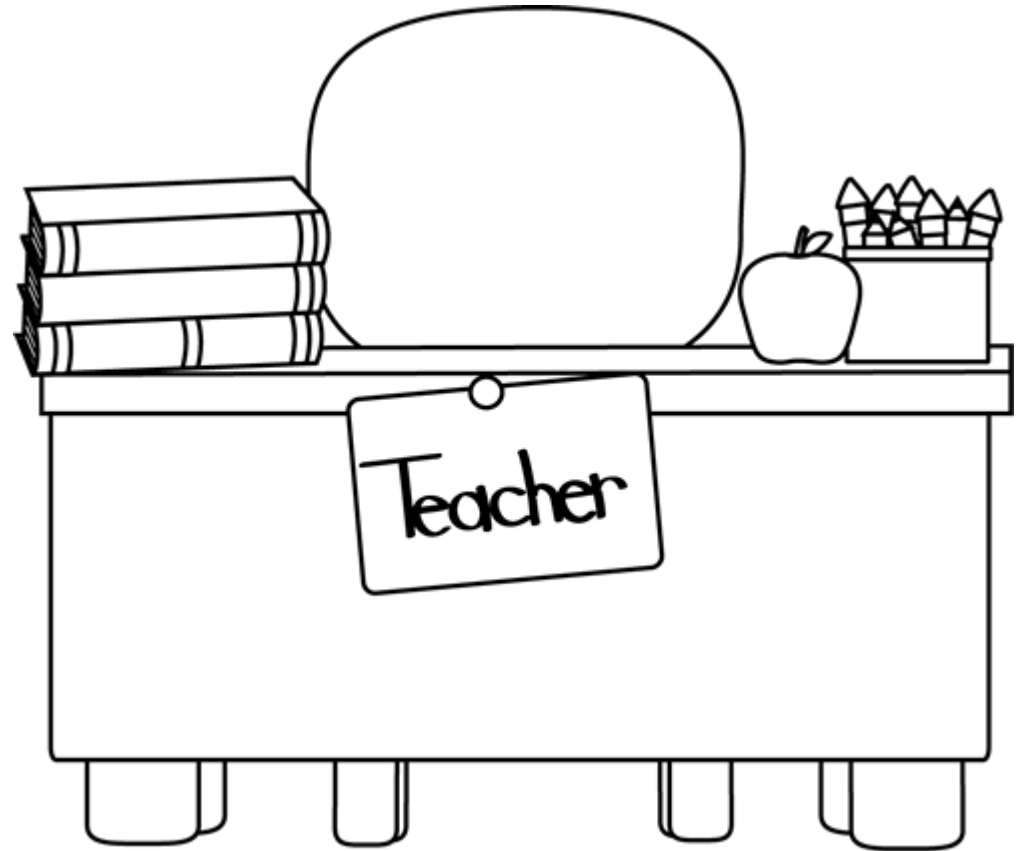
## Mr Browne
